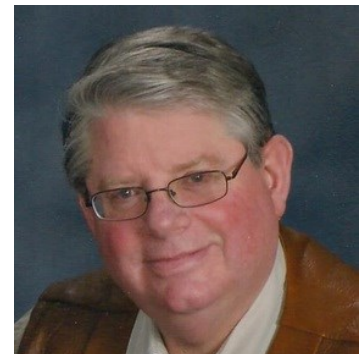
6:30 pm, Rotary Room, Main Library
