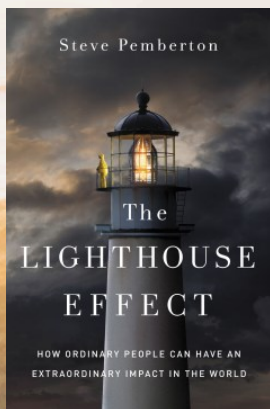


# THE CENTER FOR FAMILY JUSTICE & THE LIGHTHOUSE EFFECT
