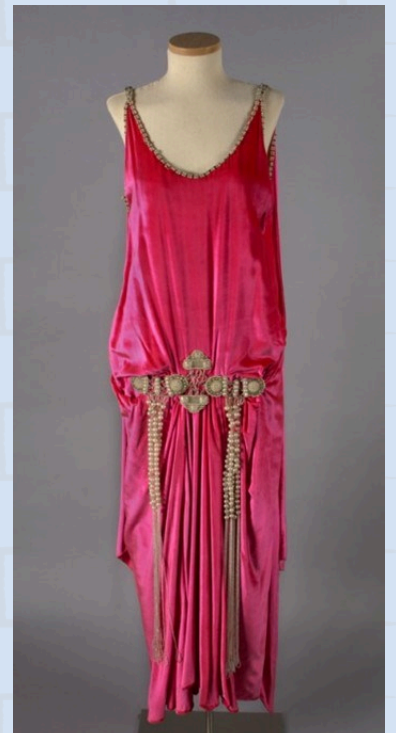




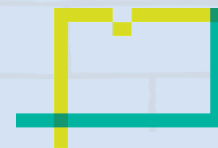
Hoopskirts to Flappers: Connecticut Fashion, 1860s -1930s
